

Cost of Living	Extremely affordable. On an average ₹ 5000 to 6000 per month for standard options.
Part Time Work	The Indian Student Visa is issued for studies only.
Visa Fees	Indian student visa fee ranges between approximately USD 13 to USD 118. Students from Nepal and Bhutan do not need any student visa to study in India. Bangladeshi students need students visa but there is no visa fee applicable. Only a small amount of visa processing fee is applicable.
Scholarships	Yes in cases the students match the eligibility criteria of the respective institutions
